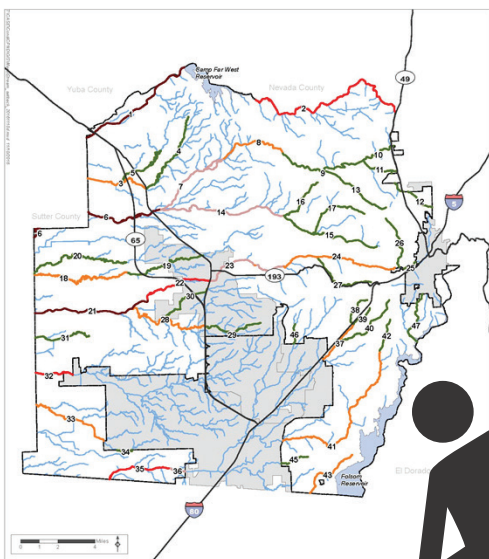


Placer County Conservation Program: **RESIDENTIAL GRADING PERMITS**

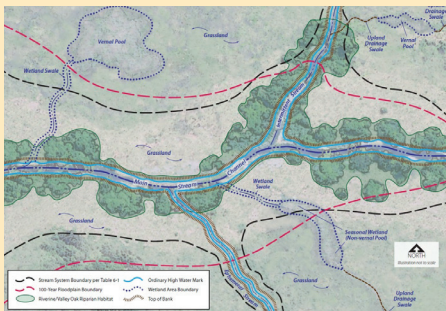
A grading permit and PCCP Certificate of Authorization is required for disturbance of 25 or more cubic yards of material within a stream system in unincorporated Placer County.



- Plan Area A
 - Non-Participating Cities
 - Reservoir
 - Highway
- Stream System Boundary Widths (see Table 6-1 for key)
- Named Stream Reaches Stream Reaches not Specified
 - 100 Feet
 - 200 Feet
 - 300 Feet
 - 400 Feet
 - 600 Feet
 - 50 Feet



The “stream system” is the stream channel (wet or dry) and the surrounding area including the FEMA flood boundary. Fees apply for permanent conversion of natural land.
