SUBJECT: Agreement with Homeless Resource Council of the Sierras

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve a revenue agreement with Homeless Resource Council of the Sierras (HRCS) in an amount not to exceed \$800,000, for the period of January 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022 to provide Emergency Shelter operations for Project Roomkey in Placer County and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign any subsequent amendments consistent with the subject matter and scope of work not to exceed \$80,000 with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

**BACKGROUND**

Due to the current COVID-19 worldwide health emergency, HHS has a need to provide emergency housing for individuals who are at risk and have no other safe lodging options or ways to self-isolate, such as homeless individuals who either have compromised immune systems or are suspected to be COVID positive. HRCS has been provided Emergency Solutions grants COVID-19 Program Emergency Shelter Operations funding from the State of California to address homelessness and they have sought qualified applicants who can provide emergency shelter operations for Project Roomkey services. HHS, Adult Systems of Care applied for and was awarded a grant for \$800,000 to continue emergency shelter services through the end of June 2021 in Placer County residents.

HHS and Procurement Services negotiated a contract with Roseville Hospitality LLC, who owns the hotel, in accordance with a contract that was reviewed and approved by County Counsel and Risk Management for this specific purpose. The County has utilized this hotel property to house individuals who have been either infected with COVID-19 or suspected to be exposed, or at high-risk for exposure but do not require hospitalization since April 17, 2020.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

These funds are from HRCS's through the State of California and are included in the Department's FY 2020-21 Budget and will be included in Future Budgets.

The Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
