WHEREAS, the Placer County Successor Agency is tasked with administering the former Placer County Redevelopment Agency (RDA) obligations and assets pursuant to Health And Safety Code section 34175(b), which includes residential and non-residential loans that originated with the former RDA;

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2013, Resolution No. 2013-038 was approved by the Successor Agency declaring that the Placer County Executive Officer, or designee, would serve as the Placer County Successor Agency Officer for purposes of overseeing the wind down affairs of the former RDA; and

WHEREAS, a resolution would affirm the Successor Agency Officer's authority to execute, enter into and modify contracts on behalf of the Successor Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Successor Agency that the Placer County Executive Officer, or designee, is designated as the Placer County Successor Agency Officer for purposes of executing, entering into and modifying contracts on behalf of the Successor Agency.
