

# Requirements for **Outdoor Sidewalk & Mobile Vendors**

## **SIDEWALK VENDORS**

**CA Senate Bill 946** defines "sidewalk vendor" as a person who sells food or merchandise from a pushcart, stand, display, pedal-driven cart, wagon, showcase, rack or other nonmotorized conveyance, or from one's person, on a public sidewalk or other pedestrian path.

### Food Vendor

- Must operate on a public sidewalk or other public pedestrian path
- Required if selling food:
  - Mobile Food Facility Permit
  - Health Permit Fee

### Merchandise Vendor

- Must operate on a public sidewalk or other public pedestrian path

## **MOBILE VENDORS & FOOD TRUCKS**

*\*Mobile vendors and food trucks are temporarily allowed without a Minor Use Permit until October 8, 2021 under the Outdoor Urgency Ordinance.*

### Food Vendor

- Allowed on public or private property (with permission from property owner)
- Must be mobile and temporary in nature
- Required:
  - *Minor Use Permit\**
  - Business license
  - Mobile Food Facility Permit
  - Health Permit Fee

### Merchandise Vendor

- Allowed on public or private property (with permission from property owner)
- Must be mobile and temporary in nature
- Required:
  - *Minor Use Permit\**
  - Design Review, if required
  - Business license
