SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing – Placer Food Bank

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$3,125 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer Food Bank as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$2,000), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250), Supervisor Holmes (\$250), Supervisor Jones (\$500) and Supervisor Gustafson (\$125).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

Placer Food Bank serves as the foremost hunger-relief charity for Placer, El Dorado, and Nevada Counties and is the region's only Feeding America-certified food bank. The organization distributes fresh and non-perishable food to the hungry through its network of local charitable agency partners, serving people of all ages throughout local communities. The Placer Food Bank is requesting funds for its Kid's Backpack Program, which is part of the organization's Feed Our Futures program. The Kid's Backpack Program provides kid-friendly and nutritious snacks every Friday during the school year to students who qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program in Roseville City, Western Placer, and Auburn school districts. Funds will be used to offset the cost of supplies for this program.

Describe the organization's purpose and/or mission and the people served.	Mission: To sustain communities by nourishing families experiencing food insecurity, educating the community about hunger, while advocating for hunger relief. We serve individuals, families, children, seniors - all those from all walks of life who are food chronically food insecure or in need of short-term food assistance through a network of agency partners in Placer, El Dorado and Nevada Counties. In FY 19-20, we distributed 6.8M pounds of food totaling 8M meals. This fiscal year, due to COVID, we anticipate distributing close to 8M pounds of food - translating close to 10M meals. Thirty percent (30%) of Seniors in our community choose between food and paying for medical expenses.

Briefly describe the program or the event for which you are requesting funds.

As part of our Feed our Future program, the funds could be allocated for either one or two key outreach programs in Placer county:

1. Kids Backpack Program – offering kid-friendly snack bags every Friday to students who qualify on the Federal Free and Reduced lunch program in four elementary schools: Cirby, Kaseberg, Rock Creek (Auburn), and Woodbridge.
2. Free Drive-thru Food Distributions, helping three of our distribution sites here in Placer County, located in Lincoln at McBean Park, Rocklin at Johnson-Springview Park and Sheridan at Celebration Family Worship. These free food distributions are held monthly at each site where we distribute boxes non-perishable food items, along with fresh produce bags.

Briefly describe how these funds we will be utilized.

Funds would be utilized toward the purchase of food items (of which PFB can purchase for pennies on the dollar through key retail partners) to enhance our inventory for the Kids Backpack Program that can include: microwave entrees (ex: ravioli or mac/cheese), fruit cups, juice boxes, cereal cups, crackers, shelf stable milk. Drive-through food distributions, purchase items for food boxes that can include: pasta, pasta sauce, rice, canned vegetables, peanut butter; perishable fresh produce bags that can include: potatoes, onions, fruit, carrots, cabbage
