ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$3,250 in Revenue Sharing monies to Gold Star Families of Roseville as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$2,000), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250) and Supervisor Jones (\$1,000).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to Gold Star Families of Roseville. The mission of America's Gold Star Families is to provide honor, hope and healing to those grieving any military loss through active duty service in the United States Armed Forces. The organization includes all branches of service representing all conflicts. Gold Star Families of Roseville is working to install a monument in the Roseville Cemetery to honor Gold Star Families and relatives who have sacrificed a loved one for our freedom. Revenue share contributions will be used to help offset the costs associated with the purchase and installation of the monument.
