SUBJECT: Department of Health Care Services Performance Agreement

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution to approve the agreement with the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), known as the Performance Agreement, that sets forth the conditions and requirements for the County to receive funding for non-Medi-Cal reimbursable behavioral health programs for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 and authorize Director of Health and Human Services to sign this agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign subsequent amendments consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

The County's Performance Agreement sets forth the conditions and requirements the County must meet in order to receive and utilize several funding resources administered by DHCS. The Performance Agreement is required by Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code and the California Code of Regulations and includes terms and conditions required by State contracts, information confidentiality and security requirements, and a HIPAA Business Associate relationship addendum.

The funding resources utilized by the County, under this agreement include: Mental Health Services Act, Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Act, Projects for Assistance in Transitions from Homelessness (PATH), Community Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG), Substance Abuse Treatment and Prevention Block Grant (SABG), and Crisis Counseling Assistance and Training Program (CCP) programs along with overseeing the County's provision of Community mental health services pursuant to the Bronzan-McCorquodale Act.

The Performance Agreement includes requirements for:

- providing involuntary treatment to persons a danger to themselves or others,
- compliance with Medi-Cal regulations for specialty mental health services,
- involvement of the Mental Health Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board to ensure citizen and professional involvement,
- compliance with provisions in law pertaining to patient rights,
- provision of required data to the DHCS,
- management of the Mental Health Services Act and other programs according to statute, and
- assisted outpatient treatment.

Placer County assures that these requirements are met with oversight by the Systems of Care Quality Assurance and Compliance unit. This unit works within the Adult and Children's Systems of Care to assure that services are provided in compliance with State regulations. Placer County mental health services continue to be a highly regarded service continuum that is identified as a model throughout California. On-going audits for all behavioral health programs affirm that Placer County can successfully manage these multiple programs and comply with State regulations and requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact as a result of this agreement.
