SUBJECT: Amendment to Revenue Agreement with the Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Commission

ACTION REQUESTED

Ratify approval of a non-monetary amendment with the Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Commission to extend the date of the Mental Health Student Services Act Grant Program agreement to August 31, 2025 in the amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign subsequent amendments up to \$100,000 consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

On July 28, 2020, Placer County Board of Supervisors approved the revenue agreement with the Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Commission ("OAC") for school wellness centers. This grant was awarded to expand the existing partnership with the Placer County Office of Education to include sites in the Auburn Union School District to deliver mental health services. This grant is part of the Mental Health Student Services Act (MHSSA) program (2019 Budget Bill, Senate Bill 75).

The OAC has determined that this grant is successful to our community and is extending the length of the agreement by one year to August 31, 2025 for Placer County to draw down any remaining unexpended funds. Unexpended funds have been a result of a variety of factors (*i.e.* delays in hiring, and staff turnover) that impede consistent recoupment of these grant dollars. This program will likely not expend all remaining dollars prior to August 2024 so this amendment is critical to claim the remaining dollars with these services until August 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT

All revenues and expenditures for FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 were included in the Department's FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 Budgets. Additionally, revenues and expenditures for subsequent fiscal years will be included in the Department's future budgets for the respective years.

The amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
