

WHEREAS, the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board has authorized and allocated \$329,827 for fiscal year 2021/2022, \$329,827 for fiscal year 2022/2023 and \$329,827 for fiscal year 2023/2024 to implement this project subject to the execution of a Standard Agreement and acknowledgment of the terms and conditions contained therein,
