ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$750 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations for the Stoneridge Neighborhood Association - as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$250), and Supervisor Jones (\$500).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the county and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the county.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve Revenue Sharing funds to the Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations for a Stoneridge Neighborhood Association celebration event. 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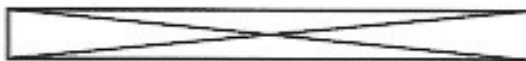
