SUBJECT: Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery multi-year revenue agreement

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a resolution approving the Intergovernmental Agreement #21-10031 with the State of California, Department of Health Care Services, for the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) initial revenue agreement in the amount of \$53,835,000, from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign subsequent amendments not to exceed an additional \$100,000 consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) utilizes the Intergovernmental Agreement in order to obligate to Placer County Federal Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) reimbursement. This contract allows Placer County to participate in the Drug Medi-Cal Organized delivery system and receive federal reimbursement for Substance Use treatment activities for Medi-Cal eligible beneficiaries in Placer County.

These funds (\$53,835,000 million dollars over 3 years) will be utilized by County staff to provide services and in contracts with community-based providers who will be delivering the required Organized Delivery System services that include: residential, outpatient, intensive outpatient, case management, recovery services, and medication assisted treatment (MAT) services.

This contract is based upon the anticipated Federal Financial Participation to Drug Medi-Cal. Amendments will occur to adjust the funding to be consistent with the estimated use of Drug Medi-Cal and the increase in expected state and federal reimbursement, as required.

FISCAL IMPACT

This multi-year revenue contract includes 90% Federal funds and 10% State General Funds. The FY 2021-22 amount is included in Department's FY 2021-22 Budget. This contract requires no County General Fund contribution.
