SUBJECT: Pass-Through of TRPA Air Quality Mitigation Funds to the Placer County Air Pollution Control District

ACTION REQUESTED

Authorize the Director of Public Works, or designee, to make a payment of \$86,375 to the Placer County Air Pollution Control District from Tahoe Regional Planning Agency Air Quality Mitigation Fund revenue for the purpose of implementing a wood stove replacement program in North Lake Tahoe.

BACKGROUND

The Placer County Air Pollution Control District (PCAPCD) secured a grant of \$86,375 from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency Air Quality Mitigation Fund towards a wood stove replacement incentive program within the Tahoe Basin. While the program is an approved use of the funds, TRPA can only release the funds to Placer County. PCAPCD staff has requested the County to receive the funds from TRPA on behalf of PCAPCD and then pay the funds to PCAPCD. The Department of Public Works (DPW) has historically received funds from TRPA for various projects and is able to implement this requested pass-through of the funds without any significant impact to workload. TRPA staff have confirmed with PCAPCD that they are in support of the pass-through of funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

This item is not a project as defined by Public Resources Code Section 21065, CEQA guideline 15378(b) and is therefore not subject to CEQA.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action is cost neutral in that DPW will receive the payment from TRPA and pay the same amount to TRPA. DPW does not require an increase in budget appropriation to accommodate the revenue or expenditure.
