SUBJECT: Agreement with AMI Housing for Homeless Outreach Services in North Tahoe

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Approve an agreement with the Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing, Inc. (AMI Housing) to provide outreach services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness in the north Tahoe area from November 20, 2021 through June 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$21,121, including the option to extend this agreement for an additional one-year term, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and sign subsequent amendments up to \$2,121, consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.
2. Approve an option to extend the agreement with Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing, Inc. (AMI Housing) for one additional year through June 30, 2023 increasing funding by \$36,015 for a new amount not to exceed \$59,257, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the amendment with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and sign subsequent amendments up to an additional \$5,925 consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

Health and Human Services collaborated with Nevada County Department of Behavioral Health to issue a Request for Information (RFI #122919) to identify contractors to provide Mental Health Services Act ("MHSA") Prevention and Early Intervention Programs in the Tahoe area and awarded a contract for services through the Placer County Board of Supervisors to Crisis Intervention Services, dba Sierra Community House on July 7, 2020. The scope of services for this contract currently includes Family Support/Parenting, Mental Health Stigma Reduction, Latino Outreach, Suicide Prevention, and Homeless Outreach serving individuals and families North Tahoe Area.

Sierra Community House notified the County that it is unable to continue to provide Homeless Outreach services due to unforeseen challenges and has requested that this service be transferred to its community partner, AMI Housing. Sierra Community House has negotiated with the County to remove Homeless Outreach services from their contract starting November 20, 2021, and the County has negotiated with AMI Housing to begin this service concurrently and avoid interruption in service delivery.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY 2021-22 amount of \$21,121 is included in the Department's FY 2021-22 Budget and if the option to extend is exercised then the \$36,015 will be included in the Department's FY 2022-23 Budget. This agreement includes 100% in State funding. No County General Funds are required.
