SUBJECT: California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Equipment Grant Agreement

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff, or a designee, to execute a grant agreement from the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways for FY 2021-22 in the amount of \$129,145 for purchase of a new vessel for the Auburn Marine Patrol Unit.
2. Approve a Budget Amendment AM-00576 increasing revenue and expenditures in the Sheriff's Marine Patrol Equipment budget, CC20001 Grants Program, to reflect the total program amount of \$129,145.

BACKGROUND

The California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways has awarded the Sheriff's Office a grant of \$129,145 for the purchase of a new vessel for the Sheriff's Auburn Marine Patrol Unit. The vessel will be used in conjunction with the existing Auburn Marine Patrol boat on lakes and rivers in Placer County including Folsom Lake, Combine Lake, Rollins Lake, Lake Clementine, Camp Far West, and French Meadows Reservoir. Additionally, this vessel will be available to participate in calls for allied agency assistance. The vessel's primary functions will include public safety and law enforcement, boater education, and Search and Rescue operations.

We request your Board adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff, or a designee, to execute the grant agreement and approve a Budget Amendment to increase the revenue and expenditures in the Sheriff's FY 2021-22 Marine Patrol Equipment budget in the CC20001 Grants Program.

FISCAL IMPACT

Upon Board approval, AM-00576 will increase revenues and expenditures in the FY 2021-22 Marine Patrol Equipment budget in CC20001 Grants Program to reflect the total program amount of \$129,145. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.
