SUBJECT: California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program Application

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff, or Sheriff's designee, to execute the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid application between Placer County and the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways. Program funding for FY 2022-23 includes State funding in the maximum amount of \$72,475 and County boat taxes estimated in the amount of \$342,813, for a total of \$415,288.

BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Office submits an annual application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways to help fund the Sheriff's Marine Patrol Program. State funds will be utilized to support the boating safety enforcement program. During summer months, the Sheriff's Office operates a full-time program at Lake Tahoe and part-time programs at Folsom Lake, Rollins Lake, Camp Far West, Lake Clementine and other smaller lakes in the area. Program funding for FY 2022-23 includes State funding in the maximum amount of \$72,475 and County boat taxes estimated in the amount of \$342,813, for a total of \$415,288. County boat tax estimates are provided by the Auditor-Controller based on the current year's actual activity.

FISCAL IMPACT

Marine Patrol Program funding of \$415,288 will be included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2022-23 Submitted Budget. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.
