SUBJECT: California Department of Parks and Recreation Off-Highway Vehicle Grant

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff, or a designee, to execute two grant awards in the combined amount of \$155,408 from the California Department of Parks and Recreation Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division for the term of September 6, 2021 to September 5, 2022. A combined county match for the two projects of \$51,804 is required.

BACKGROUND

The Placer County Sheriff's Office Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Program patrols heavy use OHV areas, responds to calls for service, and provides safety education to off-roaders using the County's OHV resources.

The OHV grant was first awarded to the Placer County Sheriff's Office in FY 2013-14 and funded the purchase of two all-terrain vehicles and related equipment. This year, the Sheriff's Office applied for two projects: one for the Auburn area and the other for Tahoe region. The Auburn program has been awarded \$69,494 with a 25% match of \$23,166, for a total program amount of \$92,660. The Tahoe program has been awarded \$85,914 with a 25% match of \$28,638, for a total program amount of \$114,552.

FISCAL IMPACT

These revenue funds are already included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2021-22 Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
