SUBJECT: Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) Per Diem

ACTION REQUESTED

Introduce an Ordinance and waive oral reading, amending Placer County Code Chapter 2, Article 2.40 to delete Section 2.40.020 regarding Local Agency Formation Commission Compensation.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56334, LAFCO may authorize payment for a per diem to commission members and alternates for each day they attend meetings of the commission. Staff is requesting your Board introduce this Ordinance to bring the County Code in alignment with Government Code and allow LAFCO to determine per diem rates paid to members.

There is no fiscal impact associated with removing this section from County Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLACER ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Placer County Code Chapter 2, Article 2.40 is hereby amended to delete Section 2.40.020 in its entirety as follows:

~~2.40.020 Local agency formation commission—Compensation.~~

~~_____ All members of the Placer County local agency formation commission shall receive compensation for their attendance at each meeting of the commission, in the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), for each day when they~~

~~are in attendance at meetings of the commission. Such payment shall be in addition to reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in attending such meetings and in performing the duties of office.~~

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage. The Clerk is directed to publish this ordinance, or a summary thereof, within fifteen (15) days in accordance with Government Code section 25124.
