SUBJECT: Willow Glen Care Center Assignment and Amendment

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve an amendment and assignment from Willow Glen Care Center, Inc. to Willow Glen Care Center and to increase the overall agreement amount by \$270,000 for a new total amount of \$870,000, to provide adult residential treatment services for mentally disabled adults for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to execute the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign amendments not to exceed \$87,000, consistent with the subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

Since 1999, Willow Glen Care Center has served Placer County in providing multiple excellent coordinated residential care and specialized programs in a safe and supportive environment for adults and older adults with severe and persistent mental illness. These comprehensive services help individuals with chronic and severe mental illness who are too disabled to live independently, but are able to live successfully in these structured living environments. These services play an integral role in the continuum of medically necessary and mental health services to Placer County adult residents each year. They further help prevent more expensive and restrictive care at our inpatient psychiatric health facility or private hospitalization. Willow Glen is one of the few facilities that also accepts individuals over the age of 65 and also those who are wheelchair dependent.

One of Willow Glen's residential facilities accepts very complex clients who are often declined by other residential treatment facilities. This acceptance rate of these complex clients allows the client to receive the appropriate level of care rather than spending excessive time on our PHF waiting. Adult Systems of Care has therefore utilized this facility more than initially anticipated requiring this increase, while using some other facilities less.

FISCAL IMPACT

The amendment now includes \$870,000 for FY 2021-22 and consists of \$522,000 (60%) in County General funds and \$348,000 (40%) in Federal and State revenues. The amount is included in the Department's FY 2021-22 Budget.
