**SUBJECT:** California Department of Public Health Immunization Outreach Grant

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director of Health and Human Services to accept additional funding from the California Department of Public Health for its Immunization Outreach Grant for allowable expenditures incurred during the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022, in an increased amount of \$3,197,482 for a total not to exceed \$3,859,042, to accept additional related funds not to exceed \$100,000, and to sign related amendments and documentation related to this grant consistent with the subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

**BACKGROUND**

Placer County has been receiving State funds from the California Department of Public Health for the Immunization Outreach Program since the mid-1990s. This agreement is tied to California Health & Safety Code that requires the Health Officer to organize and maintain a program to make immunizations available to children who are Medi-Cal eligible or uninsured and for adults who are uninsured or underinsured. These vaccines, which are required for school entry and by some employers, are provided at little to no cost. The contract will continue to allow Placer County to promote, support and improve community vaccine access by providing participating community vaccine providers with no cost vaccines, educational materials, media vaccine campaigns or participation in local clinics.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Funding for this agreement is 100% State funding from the California Department of Public Health and is included in the Department's FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 Budgets.
