

The following Resolution was duly passed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer at a regular meeting held January 25, 2022 by the following vote:



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WHEREAS, The State of California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) issued a Request for Applications (RFA), dated November 20, 2020, for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program and Placer County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) was a successful applicant.

WHEREAS, as a successful applicant HHS has been contracting with the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance through the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC) to participate in the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program.

WHEREAS, BSCC has extended the time period to utilize the funding and provide services and HHS would like to accept the amendment to extend the agreement to use the additional time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Health and Human Services, or designee, be authorized on behalf of the County of Placer Board of Supervisors to execute the amendment and sign any additional documentation with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that HHS agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
