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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve appropriation of \$950 in Revenue Sharing monies to the North Lake Tahoe Historical Society, Camp Talawanda Sign Project as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$200), Supervisor Holmes (\$250), Supervisor Jones (\$250), and Supervisor Gustafson (\$250).

**BACKGROUND**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the county and its inhabitants, therefore a benefits results to the county.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the North Lake Tahoe Historical Society, Camp Talawanda Sign Project. The mission of the North Lake Tahoe Historical Society is to collect, preserve and present the natural and cultural histories of Lake Tahoe. The Camp Talawanda Sign Project will provide an informational sign identifying the entrance to the first Girls Summer Camp at Lake Tahoe. The Camp Talawanda Sign will provide information commemorating the site of the camp and will be installed at the North Lake Tahoe Regional Park. Revenue Share contributions will help offset the cost of the design and materials for the historic sign.
