**SUBJECT:** Tahoe Truckee Unified School District Amendment

**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve an amendment with Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD) for operation of Tahoe Wellness Centers, to increase funding by \$99,102 for a new total amount not to exceed \$407,796 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the amendment with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign subsequent amendments up to an additional \$40,779 consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

**BACKGROUND**

Health and Human Services collaborated with Nevada County Department of Behavioral Health to issue a Request for Information (RFI #122919) to identify contractors to provide Mental Health Services Act ("MHSA") Prevention and Early Intervention Programs in the Tahoe area and awarded a contract for services through the Placer County Board of Supervisors to TTUSD on July 7, 2020. The approval included an option to extend the agreement for one additional year through June 30, 2023, for an additional \$102,898. The County is now exercising the option and would like to increase funding by \$99,102 for a total amount of \$202,000 for fiscal year 2022-2023. TTUSD operates Wellness Centers and/or supportive services at North Tahoe High School and Truckee High School, individualized wellness programming at Sierra High School and the Community School (Placer County Court School), and outreach and education to North Tahoe Middle School, Alder Creek Middle School and the elementary schools. While TTUSD has successfully expanded their mental health services over the last two years to respond to the high number of students who have been struggling during the COVID-19 pandemic, this additional funding will allow for the addition of a Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Specialist and a Lead Social Worker to support the TTUSD Wellness Manager in creating a more sustainable and comprehensive Wellness Program to better meet the needs of students.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The total updated FY 2022-23 amount of \$202,000 is included in the Department's FY 2022-23 Budget. This agreement includes 100% in State funding. No County General Funds are required.
