SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing – The Gathering Inn, Gathering for Hope 2022 Event

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$3,750.00 in Revenue Sharing monies to The Gathering Inn, Gathering for Hope 2022 event as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$1,000.00), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250.00), Supervisor Holmes (\$1,000.00), Supervisor Jones (\$500.00), and Supervisor Gustafson (\$1,000.00).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the The Gathering Inn, Gathering for Hope 2022 event. The vision of The Gathering Inn is to end homelessness in the community by offering comprehensive services to homeless men, women and children, addressing mental health issues, addiction, employment needs, medical and dental care, and basic needs. The goal of the organization is to help homeless individuals in the community achieve housing. The Gathering for Hope Event is a gala event to raise funds to support initiatives not funded by other revenue streams. This includes purchasing clothing, tools and uniforms for ready-to-work initiatives, transportation costs for homeless individuals to get to work and educational costs for GED classes, trade schools, apprenticeships and 2-year college costs to help individuals prepare for future employment. Revenue Share contributions will be used to help offset the cost of the fundraising event.

FISCAL IMPACT

The amount of the requested contribution is \$3,750.00. Funding is provided for in the FY 2022-23 Community and Agency Support budget (CC10018). There is no additional impact to the general fund.

Describe the organization's purpose and/or mission and the people served.

From our humble beginnings in 2004 as a winter only shelter program serving forty homeless people per night staffed with volunteers, The Gathering Inn today is a multifaceted, multi-location agency serving over 230 homeless men, women, and children each and every day right here in Placer County through four programs at eleven separate site locations with annual revenue of 5.3 million dollars. In 2021, 50% of the homeless served by The Gathering Inn who stayed in the program 10 days or more obtained housing! The Gathering Inn is the only emergency housing program for the general homeless and chronically homeless here in Placer County as well as the only provider of interim care programs for the medically fragile homeless. In addition, we have expanded in 2020 and opened permanent supportive housing homes in the community in partnership with Placer County. In 2021, TGI merged with the Lazarus Project and added more permanent supportive housing to the services offered. Through our comprehensive array of services and collaborative efforts in the community, The Gathering Inn provides cost effective and

outcome-oriented services for the homeless at 38 dollars a day per person served with over 87 cents of every dollar going directly to program services!

TGI timeline

- 2004 TGI nomadic program begins winter only out of Saint Vincent DePaul parking lot
- 2007 TGI purchases 201 Berkeley location for year-round operation
- 2009 TGI begins ICP program funded by Sutter
- 2018 TGI begins to operate Mid Placer shelter taking over for VOA
- 2018 TGI operates Whole Person Care ICP program
- 2020 TGI operates Permanent Supportive Housing program
- 2021 TGI and Lazarus Project merge adding permanent supportive homes to the combined agency
- 2022 TGI gets commitment from Sutter to add another ICP program

Gathering for Hope event 2022 is a gala event to raise discretionary funds to support initiative not funded by other revenue streams. Ongoing since 2018, this event has been supported by Placer County revenue sharing funds.
