ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,550.00 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer County Farm Bureau, Harvest Hoedown Fundraiser as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$200.00), Supervisor Weygandt (\$500.00), Supervisor Holmes (\$500.00), Supervisor Jones (\$100.00), and Supervisor Gustafson (\$250.00).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to Placer County Farm Bureau, Harvest Hoedown Fundraiser. The Placer County Farm Bureau was established in 1912 to find solutions for the farm, the farm home, and the rural community.
