SUBJECT: Edward Byrne Memorial Local Justice Assistance Grant Application

ACTION REQUESTED

Ratify submission of the Edward Byrne Memorial Local Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) application in the amount of \$16,001 to partially fund one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer County Special Investigations Unit and authorize the Sheriff to sign all required documentation.

BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Office plans to utilize the annual Local JAG Grant for FY 2022-23 to partially offset the costs of one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) task force. This position works as a liaison between SIU, the Courts, and other County departments to monitor high-risk situations for children in Placer County. To help ensure the safety and well-being of Placer County residents, the SIU works with School Resource Officers to identify individuals who are selling drugs at local schools and to determine what kinds of drugs are being sold such as methamphetamines, marijuana, and other illegal narcotics.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding in the amount of \$16,001 is included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2022-23 Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
