ACTION REQUESTED

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to St. Vincent de Paul Society for their Beverly Hillbillies Ball. St. Vincent de Paul's mission is to provide basic human services and programs to prevent hunger and homelessness. The organization provides hope and help for people in crisis including the homeless and families who are struggling financially and are at risk of becoming homeless. The Beverly Hillbillies Ball raises funds to help the organization expand their programs and services. Revenue share contributions will be used to help offset the cost of the event.
