ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,750.00 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer Community Foundation as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$250.00), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250.00), Supervisor Holmes (\$500.00), Supervisor Jones (\$500.00) and Supervisor Gustafson (\$250.00).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the Placer Community Foundation for its 2023 Nonprofit Initiative. The Placer Community Foundation's Nonprofit Initiative was developed to help organizations deliver higher quality, sustainable and valuable community services through a variety of training programs and community events, including the annual Leadership Summit. The Summit provides an opportunity for local organizations to strengthen their board volunteers and executive staff by helping them understand powerful techniques for fundraising and effective organization governance. Revenue Sharing funds will be used to help cover the costs associated with the event.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this action is \$1,750.00. Funding for this contribution is available in the FY2022-23 budget for CC10018 – Community and Agency Support. There is no additional impact to the general fund.
