SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing – Roseville Police Activities League

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,250.00 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Roseville Police Activities League as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$750.00), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250.00), and Supervisor Jones (\$250.00).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the Roseville Police Activities League (PAL). The Roseville Police Activities League provides a variety of year-round programs and services for Roseville youth ages 8 to 17. PAL also helps to build meaningful relationships between Roseville youth, police officers, and the community through various events and activities. The goal of the organization is to keep costs for youth-oriented programs and activities low in order to avoid the exclusion of any child from these opportunities due to family income levels. Revenue Share contributions will be used to help offset the cost of materials needed to support programs and activities that run year-round.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this action is \$1,250.00. Funding for this contribution is available in the FY2022-23 budget for CC10018 – Community and Agency Support. There is no additional impact to the general fund.

Describe the organization's purpose and/or mission and the people served.

Enrich the lives of Roseville youth by building positive relationships between youth, police officers, and the community through a broad range of accessible and affordable activities.

We have 29 years of community impact, 2023 will be our 30th anniversary! Prior to COVID we regularly had over 300 youth actively engaged in our afterschool programs. During COVID we adjusted and have been able to continue serving around 125 youth. We are building our afterschool programs back up to support our pre COVID numbers of 300 youth this year.

Briefly describe the program or the event for which you are requesting funds.

Our focus is to make programs and extra curricular activities affordable for families. We remain low cost and non exclusionary so that Roseville youth are offered opportunities to engage with the community and develop their interests in a safe environment. We have regular enrollments in our boxing

and Tae Kwon Do Programs. We run a Homework Help Center that provides free tutoring from interns in partnering area colleges and Universities. We also offer short-course (8 week) extra curricular series that focus on courses and activities that are typically offered through private organizations outside the economic reach of our constituents. The programs include art, STEM, reading, creative writing, secondary language and many others. By changing our programs every 8 weeks we can introduce youth to a variety of pursuits without burn-out. We also run a summer program that not only gives youth a safe, supervised and supportive environment and feeds them a nutritious lunch.

We aim to serve the under privileged but welcome all youth in Roseville. The ultimate goal is to build community and meet people where they are.

Briefly describe how Revenue Sharing funding would be utilized. (Please list items and activities to be funded with any Revenue Sharing funds allotted. Funding cannot be used for core budget needs or program or event staffing such as security, instructors, cleanup crews, etc.)

Funding will be used to purchase materials to support youth programs and activities that run all year long. These materials are program specific and are not operational costs to RPAL. All materials will be used by the youth participants we serve. These items range from art supplies to science materials to sports equipment that will support the programs, activities and services taught/offered.
