Loomis Basin Christmas Basket Program

For over 20 years the Loomis Basin Christmas Basket (LBCB) Program has provided food, toys, and books for families in need that reside in the Loomis basin area: Ophir, Newcastle, Penryn, Loomis, and Rocklin. We serve approximately 300 families (over 1000 people) each year. For the last two years because of COVID concerns we gave food and toy gift cards out with a drive-through event.

We are happy to be able to include our community again with the gathering of toys and food and the organization of the food boxes on the Saturday morning before the event. We usually have 150 community members come out to help.

LBCB is registered as a 501c3 Non-Profit Organization that provides a wonderful service, supported by many Loomis Basin Organizations and Businesses. LBCB is governed by a Board of Directors that oversee each year's efforts and results.

The event uses the facility provided by the First United Methodist Church of Loomis for a three-week period that includes the donated food and gift gathering storage, sorting of food and gifts, as well as the food basket filling, distribution, and deliveries.

The annual LBCB program provides wonderful volunteer opportunities for groups and individuals to engage in an effort that is focused on improving the Holiday season for those less fortunate in our local area. Any donated food that is left over after the event is donated to the Loomis Basin Food Pantry that runs Monday-Fridays all year.
