Re: Request for a Chip Seal of McKeon-Ponderosa Road

Dear Mr. Whittle,

We received your letter dated October 5, 2016. County representatives met with the Ad-Hoc Committee on November 10th and 17th to discuss the status of McKeon-Ponderosa Road based on previous actions taken by the Board of Supervisors. We also discussed some possible alternative courses of action that the property owners could pursue.

Presumably your request is for the section of McKeon-Ponderosa Road south of Bradley Way. There are two separate sections north of Bradley Way that are in the County's maintained mileage system. The County resurfaced those two sections this summer.

The section south of Bradley Way is a private road. The County has no authority to spend public funds to perform any maintenance activities on that section of road. The private property owners are responsible for operation and maintenance of the road as they see fit. As such, we cannot support the Forum's recommendation, and must deny the request.
