


Meetings

- Advise the Placer County Department of Health and Human Services on matters relating to the creation and delivery of services for Placer County's older adults.
- Advise local and regional agencies on service creation and delivery for Placer County's older adults.



Responsibilities

The OAAC Board members are charged with the responsibilities to:

- Evaluate services provided to the older adults in Placer County and make recommendations regarding unmet needs.
- Review applications and make recommendations for funding services through Agency on Aging\Area 4.



- Advocate for increased services for older adults in Placer County.
- Review legislation impacting older adults and provide reports to the Placer County Board of Supervisors.
