Governor George Deukmejian appointed Rocklin, Placer County resident Alice Gonzales as the first Executive Director of the California Department of Aging in 1983.

The Agency on Aging/Area 4 is the largest area agency on aging in the state in that it serves the largest number of jurisdictions of seven counties with the largest rural, geographically isolated population, covering 6,578 square miles. The mission of the Agency on Aging/Area 4 is to enrich the lives of older adults and people of disabilities.
