SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing – Lincoln Rotary Club Foundation, 21st annual Tour de Lincoln bike ride

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,200 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Lincoln Rotary Club Foundation, 21st annual Tour de Lincoln bike ride as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$200), and Supervisor Landon (\$1,000).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support Lincoln Rotary Club Foundation, 21st annual Tour de Lincoln bike ride. The Mission of the Rotary Club of Lincoln is to create fellowship among business, professional and civic leaders through participation in charitable projects that seek to meaningfully improve our community's quality of life. Tour de Lincoln offers cyclists a day of cycling after selecting one of three scenic courses on back roads of Lincoln and South Placer County. This event has historically attracted visitors from Northern California and Nevada, generating revenue for local hotels and eateries. Proceeds from the Tour De Lincoln will be used to support a teamwork/ leadership program for 20 students from the Phoenix Continuation High School. Revenue Share contributions will be used to help offset the cost of the event.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this action is \$1,200. Funding for this contribution is available in the FY 2023-24 budget for CC10002 – Board of Supervisors. There is no additional impact to the general fund.
