ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,750 in Revenue Sharing monies to The Forgotten Soldier Program, Fallen Heroes 111 – Mile Motorcycle Ride as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$250), Supervisor Landon (\$250), Supervisor Holmes (\$500), Supervisor Jones (\$500), and Supervisor Gustafson (\$250).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support The Forgotten Soldier Program, Fallen Heroes 111 – Mile Motorcycle Ride. The Forgotten Soldier Program is a non-profit that is dedicated to providing one-on-one care, suicide prevention, retreats, and informational workshops for Veterans, Active Military and First Responders at no cost to them. The care focuses on physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, and whole-body health of the heroes within our community. The Fallen Heroes 111 – Motorcycle Ride Serves as a powerful tribute to these individuals and allows the community to come together and remember their sacrifices and show appreciation. Revenue share contributions will be used help offset the cost of the event including essential expenses such as portable toilets, wash stations, food, drinks, utensils, paper plates, and napkins.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this action is \$1,750. Funding for this contribution is available in the FY 2023-24 budget for CC10002 – Board of Supervisors. There is no additional impact to the general fund.
