Plan background

Placer County is developing a Sustainability Plan! This Plan will outline how the community and county can reduce greenhouse gas emissions in a way that maximizes economic benefits from energy savings and operational costs, improves infrastructure, and further benefits the county and community.

The plan will:

- identify key sources of GHG emissions within the unincorporated county,
- provide a strategy to reduce GHG emissions and assist statewide goals, and
- establish resources to help residents adapt to the effects of extreme weather conditions.
