

Coordinator Responsibilities

1. Assure all participating food vendors have a valid Temporary Food Facility (TFF) Vendor Authorization with Placer County Env. Health. "FOOD" means a raw, cooked, or processed edible substance, ice, BEVERAGE, an ingredient used or intended for use or for sale in whole or in part for human consumption and chewing gum (This includes alcoholic beverage vendors).
2. Provide adequate sanitation support services for the event, such as chemical toilets with hand washing stations, janitorial services, and waste disposal.
3. Ensure food vendors post their **TFF Vendor Authorization** and daily **Placer County TFF Self-Inspection Checklist** in a location visible to the public during all hours of operation.
