SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Purchase Order as a Result of a City of Roseville Competitively Awarded Contract with Sacramento Truck Center for One Three-Axle Dump Truck in the Total Amount of \$123,180.86

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the award of a purchase order (PO) as the result of a City of Roseville competitively awarded contract with Sacramento Truck Center of Sacramento for one three-axle dump truck in the total amount of \$123,180.86, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting PO.

BACKGROUND

On February 10, 2011, the Roseville City Council approved the purchase of one three-axle Freightliner dump truck, as the result of the City's competitive Request for Quote (RFQ) 1960, from Sacramento Truck Center of Sacramento (California). The Department of Public Works Fleet Services Division requested to purchase one three-axle dump truck like the unit purchased by the City of Roseville, using pricing from the City of Roseville's contract. The vehicle will be used for various road maintenance projects conducted by the Department of Public Works Road Maintenance Division.

Sacramento Truck Center submitted a cost proposal in the amount of \$123,180.86. The vendor used the same base pricing that the City of Roseville paid. The Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e) (3) permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County.

FISCAL IMPACT

The PO resulting from this recommendation will total \$123,180.86. The Department of Public Works' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
