**SUBJECT:** Adopt Resolution Calling the June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election and Authorizing the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for Certain Special District, School District and City Elections Requested to be Combined with the June 5, 2012 Election

**RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt the attached resolution calling the June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election and authorizing the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render election services for certain special district, school district and city elections that are requested to be combined with the June 5, 2012 election.

**BACKGROUND**

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year. Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that city, special district and school governing bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to said bodies on a reimbursable basis. For the County Clerk to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303, approval of your Board is required, and a resolution ordering the June 3, 2012 election, including the requested city and district elections, is attached.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for a list of jurisdictions seeking election and requested ballot measures.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Requesting jurisdictions will pay for their costs for these special elections based on the approved fee schedule for election services. Appropriations for costs necessary for conducting the elections for federal, state, and countywide offices on June 5, 2012 have been included in the current FY 2011-12 Budget for the County Elections Office.

**Measures to Appear at the  
June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election**

**Measure A – City of Auburn**

(Placer County only)

Requires a simple majority to pass

Shall the Home Rule for Auburn Charter of 2012 be adopted?

**Measure C – Foresthill Public Utility District**

(Placer County only)

Requires a simple majority to pass

Shall Measure B, which rolled back the District's water rates, be repealed to allow the District to set rates sufficient to meet the costs of providing water service?

**Measure D – North Auburn - Ophir Fire (CSA 28, Zone 193)**

(Placer County only)

Requires 2/3 voter approval to pass

Shall an ordinance be adopted to increase existing direct charges for residential development by \$40 per unit; for mobile home parks by \$20 per unit; for commercial/ industrial development by \$0.046 per square foot for fire protection, emergency medical, prevention services and equipment replacement in North Auburn – Ophir Fire (CSA 28, Zone 193) (Charges approved in this measure are subject to an annual cost of living adjustment not to exceed 3% in any year)?

**Measure E – Placer Hills Fire Protection District**

(Placer County only)

Requires 2/3 voter approval to pass

Shall Placer Hills Fire Protection District be allowed to impose a Special Tax to maintain the current level of fire and life safety services and replace essential equipment, vehicles and facilities?

**Measure F – North Lake Tahoe Transient Occupancy Tax**

(Placer County only)

Requires a simple majority to pass

NORTH LAKE TAHOE T-O-T CONTINUATION MEASURE WITH NO TAX INCREASE.  
To reduce traffic congestion/tourist impacts, support transportation services, build/maintain local bike trails, parks, indoor recreation opportunities, sidewalks, and beaches, and other public services, shall Placer County continue for 10 additional years, with no increase, the existing 2% North Lake Tahoe portion of the Transient Occupancy Tax – paid only by lodging guests, not by local taxpayers – with annual independent audits, continued local oversight, and all funds exclusively for North Lake Tahoe?
