BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Placer High School Grad Night Alive Celebration being held on June 9th at the Auburn Recreation District gymnasium. Parents introduced this safe and sober grad night in 1989 as an alternative for graduates to celebrate their success in a safe and sober environment and to ensure both their safety and that of our community. This event has become a popular tradition that graduating students enjoy and look forward to each year. Since parents, schools and communities have joined to arrange grad night celebrations, there has been a significant decline in the death toll during the weeks of high school graduation. The funds designated will help defray the cost of the event and help offset the cost to the students.


