SUBJECT: Adopt Resolution Authorizing the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for the Twin Rivers Unified School District Measure Election Consolidated with the June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election.

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render election services for a measure election for the Twin Rivers Unified School District to be consolidated with the June 5, 2012 statewide Presidential Primary Election.

BACKGROUND

Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Sections 5302 and 5303 provide that the County Superintendent of Schools may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to conduct an election within a school district and permit the county elections official to render necessary election services to the district on a reimbursable basis.

The Sacramento County Superintendent of Schools on March 1, 2012 adopted a resolution, requesting the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to conduct a measure election for the Twin Rivers Unified School District, a portion of which lies within Placer County, to be consolidated with the June 5, 2012 statewide Presidential Primary Election.

For the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to perform the election functions requested by the Sacramento Superintendent of Schools pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section and 5303, approval of your Board is required, and a resolution ordering the requested measure election is attached.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Twin Rivers Unified School District will pay for the requested measure election costs based on the Placer County's approved fee schedule for election services.

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Superintendent of Schools has ordered an election to be held on June 5, 2012 in the Twin Rivers Unified School District consolidated with the Presidential Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Twin Rivers Unified School District lies within the boundaries of Placer County; and

WHEREAS, the wording for said measure has been delivered to the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters and is presented to the Placer County Board of Supervisors as Exhibit A (see attached); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code and Sections 5203 and 5303 of the Education Code, the County Superintendent of Schools may request the Board of Supervisors to call elections and permit the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render specified services to school districts relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors that the Twin Rivers Unified School District Election be held on June 5, 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer hereby authorizes the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render any and all necessary election services to the District services and to be reimbursed for the costs of said services as provided by the approved fee schedule.
