Approve appropriation of \$1,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Placer County Japanese American Citizens League (JACL) to benefit the 100th Battalion / 442<sup>nd</sup> Regimental Combat Team Memorial, as requested by Supervisor Holmes (\$1,000).

**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked for their continued support of the Placer County Japanese American Citizens League (JACL). The Placer County JACL and Placer County have partnered to erect a bronze statue called the "Battle of the Lost Battalion" at the Bill Santucci Justice Center in Roseville to honor and remember Americans of Japanese ancestry who served in WW II. Founded in 1929, the JACL is the oldest and largest civil rights organization in the United States whose ongoing mission is to secure and maintain the civil rights of Japanese Americans.

The funds designated will help to pay for the cost of completing the statue, estimated to be finished by Veteran's Day of 2012.
