SUBJECT: Change Order to Gen-Probe Blanket Purchase Order

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve a Change Order to Blanket Purchase Order No. BP018553 with Gen-Probe for sexually transmitted infections (STI) testing supplies and reagents, increasing the amount of the agreement by \$15,000, for a revised total of \$60,000 from May 13, 2011 through June 30, 2012, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the change order.

BACKGROUND:

The Placer County Health and Human Services offers testing and treatment for STIs in order to decrease potential lifelong complications of individuals living with undiagnosed STIs while also decreasing the further transmission of these infections to others in the community. In 2011, over 5,000 tests for STIs were provided to individuals that obtained services at Placer County Community Clinics or via medical services provided to inmates at Placer County Jail and Juvenile Detention facilities.

The total dollar amount for this BPO was not adequate for unanticipated increases in demands for testing. The revised amount is now consistent with projected expenditures based on utilization, and the BPO amount will be adjusted in future years to allow more cushion for such increases.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This \$15,000 increase is included in the Department's FY 2011-12 Final Budget, 100% of the cost of the increase is paid for with State funding. The BPO amount requested in the Department's proposed FY 2012-13 budget reflects expected continuing increases in demand for services.
