SUBJECT: LAKE TAHOE MARATHON

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution supporting the Lake Tahoe Marathon and the temporary restriction of traffic on State Highway 89 on Sunday, September 30, 2012.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

Mr. Les Wright, Race Director, of the Lake Tahoe Marathon, has requested the Board's support for the marathon and the staggered interruptions of traffic on State Highway 89 from Tahoe City to South Lake Tahoe over a period of several hours on race day. In order to conduct the event, Caltrans must issue an encroachment permit for the use of the State Highway. Caltrans has requested that the County take a position on the event.

The races begin in Tahoe City and start at 6:30 AM. The road would reopen behind the participants at a rate of 11 minutes per mile. Therefore, the road between Tahoe City and Homewood would be open by 8:15 AM and to Tahoma by 8:30 AM.

There will be wheelchair entries and for their safety, one lane must be closed.

Caltrans and the California Highway Patrol will handle traffic control.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This action is exempt under CEQA guidelines per Section 15301(c) Operation of Existing Highways and Streets.

FISCAL IMPACT

There will be no fiscal impacts to the County for this race. Increased sales taxes and lodging fees can be expected from the race participants, support personnel and the media.
