Approve Commendations congratulating the following six (6) Boy Scouts on completing all the requirements needed to obtain their Eagle Scout designation with the Boy Scouts of America: Thomas Edward Martin, Jarrett James McBride, Arpan Silas Rajan, Nathan Woodruff, Trevor Fischer, and Luke Summers.

**BACKGROUND**

Eagle Scout is the highest rank attainable in the Boy Scouting program of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA). A Scout who attains this rank is called an *Eagle Scout* or *Eagle*. Since its introduction in 1911, the Eagle Scout rank has been earned by more than 2 million young men. The title of Eagle Scout is held for life, thus giving rise to the phrase "Once an Eagle, always an Eagle."

Requirements include earning at least 21 merit badges and demonstrating Scout Spirit through the Boy Scout Oath and Law, service, and leadership. This includes an extensive service project that the Scout plans, organizes, leads, and manages. The Eagle Scout Service Project is the opportunity for a Scout to demonstrate leadership of others while performing a project for the benefit of any religious institution, any school, or his community. The project may not benefit the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) or its councils, districts, units, camps and so forth. It also cannot be of a commercial nature or be solely a fund-raising project.


Eagle Scouts are presented with a medal and a badge that visibly recognizes the accomplishments of the Scout. Additional recognition can be earned through Eagle Palms, awarded for completing additional tenure, leadership, and merit badge requirements.

All six of these young men have completed all the requirements and have earned the rank of Eagle Scout.



The boxes were approximately 4 feet by 8 feet, and were built from pressure-treated wood that was capped with a specialized layer of Trex® boards designed to prevent children from getting splinters. The boxes were filled with a layer of dirt and fertilized garden soil, and then painted with a layer of stain to improve their appearance and to add protection. The two garden boxes will be used to educate children for years to come; and

**Whereas**, Jarrett graduated from Roseville High School with a 3.0156 GPA, and plans to attend Sierra College in the Fall, and intends to transfer to a 4 year university. His goal is to obtain a degree in Computer Science.






