

Subject: Agreement between the Mountain and Valley Marijuana Investigation Team and the Placer County Sheriff's Office

Action Requested

Approve the agreement between the Placer County Sheriff's Office and the Mountain and Valley Marijuana Investigation Team (MAVMIT) for the reimbursement of Task Force Officer overtime, for the period of January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012 in the amount of \$36,000 and authorize the Sheriff to sign and execute the agreement.

Background

The Sheriff's Office was invited to participate on the MAVMIT Regional Task Force. This Regional Task Force works complex cases involving Drug Trafficking Organizations. They conduct surveillance, manage informants and participate in undercover operations. The primary focus of the Task Force is on Marijuana cases but they also handle major drug trafficking cases. The Placer County Sheriff Deputy assigned to the task force will focus primarily on Placer County drug cases. Participation on this Task Force supports the goals and objectives associated with our Community Oriented Policing (COPS) grant program. This agreement provides \$36,000 annually to cover the overtime costs associated with the Deputy assigned to the Task Force. The term of the agreement shall be for one calendar year beginning on January 1, 2012. It shall be renewed automatically on January 1st of each year thereafter.

Fiscal Impact

Funds in the amount of \$36,000 from this agreement will be included in our FY 2012-2013 Final Budget. Expenses against this agreement commence July 1, 2012. There is no impact to the General Fund.

REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE MOUNTAIN AND VALLEY
MARIJUANA INVESTIGATION TEAM AND
THE PLACER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

This Reimbursement Agreement (RA) is to establish that the Mountain and Valley Marijuana Investigation Team (MAVMIT) enters into an agreement with the Placer County Sheriff's Office for the purpose of reimbursing the MAVMIT Task Force Officer's overtime.

The MAVMIT enters into an agreement with the Placer County Sheriff's Office, and agrees to reimburse the Placer County Sheriff's Office up to \$36,000.00 annually for the Task Force Officer's overtime and benefits, if funds are available, for the period January 1, 2012 through indefinite. This equates to 480 hours of overtime and benefits per calendar year, for the duration of this agreement. The Task Force Officer's overtime will be paid by the Placer County Sheriff's Office. The MAVMIT will then reimburse the Placer County Sheriff's Office for overtime, in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.

Requests for reimbursement shall be made on a monthly basis and should be forwarded to the MAVMIT as soon as practical after the first month following the month for which overtime reimbursement is requested. Reimbursement expense invoices will be prepared by the Placer County Sheriff's Office and will be provided to the MAVMIT for reimbursement.

The Placer County Sheriff's Office shall bill the MAVMIT at: P. O. Box 5696, El Dorado Hills, CA 95762, Attn: Task Force Commander (916) 869-1398. The MAVMIT will reimburse the Placer County Sheriff's Office by issuing a check to: Placer County Sheriff's Office, 2929 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95602, Attn: Fiscal.

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. The MAVMIT and the California DOJ/DLE have executed this Reimbursement Agreement through their duly authorized officers effective January 1, 2012.
