SUBJECT: Call the Specified, Requested Elections and Authorize the County Registrar of Voters to Render Reimbursed Election Services for the Elections Consolidated with the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the attached resolution calling the specified, requested elections and authorizing the County Registrar of Voters to render reimbursed election services for the elections to be consolidated with the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election, generating an estimated \$750,000 in reimbursements from requesting jurisdictions.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in November of each even-numbered year. Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that special district, city and school district Governing Bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Elections Official to render necessary election services to said Bodies on a reimbursable basis. For the Placer County Registrar of Voters to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code 5303, the Registrar needs approval by resolution from the Board of Supervisors.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for a list of jurisdictions seeking election and requested ballot measures.

FISCAL IMPACT

Estimated full costs, including ballot printing, postage, precinct costs, Elections labor, and Elections and County Administrative costs for the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election are projected at \$2.4 million, and are fully budgeted in the FY 2012-13 Proposed Budget. For elections that are consolidated with the November General Election, the requesting jurisdictions will pay for a pro-rata share of costs based on the approved fee schedule for election services. The FY 2012-13 Proposed Budget includes \$750,000 in revenue for these November General Election district and city reimbursements.
