Subject: Agreement between the California Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement (DLE) and the Placer County Sheriff's Office

Action Requested

1. Approve Amendment No. 1 (Exhibit A) to the Agreement with the California Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement (DLE) to fund the Task Force Commander position for the Placer Special Investigation Unit (Placer SIU), with a budgeted net county cost of \$166,840, for a one year period from January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013, and authorize the Sheriff to sign and execute the amendment.

Background

In January 2012, the Sheriff's Office was notified that the State would be eliminating several DLE Commander positions in California including the Task Force Commander assigned to Placer SIU. Subsequently, our office requested and your Board approved an agreement authorizing the Sheriff's Office to fund the position with available California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine (CaMMET) funding. The Sheriff's Office was recently notified by the State that the Commander's position will not be funded again in 2013 and requests an amendment to the original agreement to extend funding for the position for an additional year. The Task Force Commander is a key position utilized to manage the task force and successfully reduce drug trafficking in our region by working with Sheriff's staff and Placer Law Enforcement Agencies (PLEA).

Fiscal Impact

The SIU Task Force Commander position will be funded with available California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine (CaMMET) funding. Total cost for this reimbursement agreement is unchanged from the prior year at \$166,840, which covers the Commander's salary, benefits and overtime, and is included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2012-13 Final Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
