Subject: Anti-Drug Abuse (ADA) Enforcement Program

Action Requested

1. Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff to execute a grant award from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) Anti-Drug Abuse (ADA) Enforcement Program in the amount of \$141,922, to fund one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer Special Investigation Unit from October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2013.

Background

The Sheriff's Office receives annual funding from the BSCC Justice Assistance Grant program for local Anti-Drug Abuse (ADA) Enforcement Programs. The funds are utilized for the costs of one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer Special Investigations Unit (SIU) Task Force. SIU contributes to the safety and well-being of the Placer County residents and is part of the County's fight against drugs such as methamphetamines. This task force is comprised of allied police agencies, the Sheriff, District Attorney and Probation department within Placer County along with assistance provided as needed from Health and Human Services. It is intended that the current grant application will continue to fund one Deputy Sheriff's operational costs and training.

Fiscal Impact

ADA Enforcement Grant funding is included in the Sheriff's FY 2012-13 Budget. There is no additional fiscal impact to the General Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the implementing agency/organization and partnering entities agree to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the federal Justice Assistance Grant Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors approves the grant application between Placer County Sheriff's Office and the Board of State and Community Corrections in the maximum amount of \$141,922 and authorizes Sheriff-Coroner-Marshal, Edward N. Bonner, to execute the grant award.
