

**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS**

The Auburn Rotary Club in partnership with the City of Auburn's Endurance Capital of the World Committee will be hosting the 6th Annual Community Day 10K/5K Road Races & Fun Run/Walk on Saturday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at the Placer High School Track. The event is expected to attract over 2,000 people. The money raised during this event will be used to assist the Auburn Placer Performing Arts Center and the Auburn Rotary's Scholarship Endowment Fund. The goal of the Auburn Rotary Club is to establish a \$200,000 endowment fund for scholarships that can be drawn from each year. The scholarships are awarded to high school seniors for academic and vocational education. The funds designated towards this event will help pay for the music entertainment and activities for the children.

**The Auburn Rotary Club in partnership with the City of Auburn's Endurance Capital of the World Committee will host the sixth Annual Community Day 10K/5K Road Races & Fun Run/Walk on Saturday, May 20th, 2006 at the Placer High School Track. Our theme this year will be "Helping to educate our students and assist our Auburn Performing Arts Center. Last year's Community Day raised over \$40,000 to assist with Seniors First/Senior Link and the Rotary Scholarship Endowment Fund. This year promises to surpass all expectations of business and community leaders.**

**Auburn Performing Arts Center is a non-profit corporation organized to reconstruct the old (1931) State Theatre into a State of the art facility. It will be an 821 seat Theatre and Cultural Center. It will be the home of the Auburn Symphony and will be a showpiece of Auburn and add to the "Good Life" in the foothills.**

**Auburn Rotary Club has a goal of establishing a \$200,000 endowment fund from which money for scholarships can be drawn each year. Scholarships are awarded to high school seniors for academic and vocational education. Part of this year's proceeds will benefit this endowment.**

**The Community Day, with attendance expected to exceed 2,000 individuals, will include Road Races and a Fun Run/Walk for all ages and abilities as well as health oriented screenings and information booths and a pancake breakfast. There will also be music, entertainment and activities for the children. The event's highlight will be the raffling off a \$3,000 trip for two to Hawaii. The raffle tickets will be sold for \$20 each or 6 for \$100.00.**
