Subject: **RATIFY PURCHASE OF MATERIALS FOR THE RONALD L. FEIST PARK
PROJECT AT DISCOUNTED COST AND APPROVE PAYMENT**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION: Ratify the purchase of concrete for the Ronald L. Feist Park Project and approve payment for the purchase of concrete to Kiwanis Club of Granite Bay in the amount of \$5,000.

BACKGROUND: The County of Placer has been working closely with the Eureka Union School District and a very active Granite Bay community on the construction of the Ronald L. Feist community Park located on 18.4 acres on Twin School Road in the Granite Bay area. As such, the community has actively solicited contributions towards improvements at the park site including tot lots, a picnic structure, sidewalks, snack bar/restroom building, plaza area, irrigation supplies, etc. Included in the contributions are two concrete suppliers who provided concrete for various improvements at a discounted cost.

Cedar Valley Concrete provided concrete services valued at \$15,000 to the Kiwanis Club of Granite Bay at a discounted price of \$10,000 for sidewalks at the park. Kiwanis agreed to pay \$5,000 of the remaining cost if Placer County could contribute the balance of \$5,000. Pursuant to the attached invoice, Kiwanis has paid the full \$10,000 and is now requesting reimbursement of the County's contribution.

A dedication of the Ronald L. Feist Park is scheduled at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 6, 2006.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: The Eureka Union School District Board of Trustees filed a Negative Declaration for construction of Ronald L. Feist Park on April 25, 2000, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is funding available with the Feist Park Construction Project Account to pay these expenditures. The Ronald L. Feist Park would cost approximately \$3,000,000 to construct if all items were subjected to public bid. Volunteer efforts and contributions towards the construction of this project have reduced the county's cost of the project by roughly half.
